Maurice has his own style and method he uses which has been developed from his study and tutelage from other well known bird dog trainers who have literally "re-written the books" on bird dog training, including Dave Walker, Bill Gibbons, Cliff Sharer, and Bill West. Mo, as he is known by his friends and followers, is constantly working with his dogs and constantly re-writing, re-energizing, and re-inventing his own training method.

1. Introducing pups to birds and gunfire.
2. Introducing the e-collar and teaching your dog to handle.
3. Detailed instruction on using remote launchers and Higgins releasers.
4. Steady-to-wing-and-shot training and how to get started.
5. Problem dogs and problem solving.
